A workshop On Process-Based Problem Based Learning was conducted online on 16 March 2023. The event was organized by Al Shifa College of Pharmacy and conducted by QUEST International University, Ipoh, Malaysia on behalf of MoU signed between the colleges. The programme started with a welcome by Prof (Dr) TNK Suriyapraksh, Principal, Al Shifa College of Pharmacy followed by Dr. Ng Yen Ping, Assoc. Prof. QUEST International University, Ipoh, Malaysia . The academic session started at 8.45 am (IST) Prof. Datuk Dr Allan Mathews, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Ng Kwok Kwen, Prof. Dr. Syed Atif Abbas, Assoc. Prof. Dr Vijay Kotra and Assoc. Prof. Dr. Mahibub Kanakal delivered session on various aspects of PBL including Historical Perspective of PBL, Components of Process-Driven PBL, Facilitation during PBL Sessions, Preparing Facilitator Notes, Creating a Proper Trigger and Rubric for Assessment.
