1. WASTE MANAGEMENT AND ECOFRIENDLY APPROACHES The seminar was conducted by NSS unit of Al Shifa College of Pharmacy. The Resourse Person was Mr. ANOOP MENON, Sr. Technical Associate, Socio Economic Unit, Kizhattur. Prof. JUNISE V, Vice Principal, Al Shifa College of Pharmacy address welcome speech. All non-teaching and teaching staffs are the participants/ audience. He said that importance of waste management and

how we can manage/discard the waste, that produced by any labs or college or house etc. He also mentioned the project by government "Haritha Karma Sena" is a micro-entrepreneurial initiative under Kudumbashree Mission. The business can be of any type, such as upcycling (transforming the waste materials into new products), distribution and maintenance of bio-bins and or even servicing the solar power panels. He says that waste management reduces the effect of waste on the environment, health and so on. It can also help reuse or recycle resource, such as paper, cans, glass, and so on. He suggested that Different coloured dust bins are placed in many locations of Laboratories, classroom, corridors and washrooms for the segregation of different type of wastes as per requirement. Yellow coloured bin for collecting infectious waste, Red bin for plastic waste, Blue bin for collecting broken glasses and Black bins for general waste. Every 2 months of periods "Haritha Karma Sena" team will come and collect the wastes. Haritha Karma Sena has agreed to sign MOU towards the waste management.













#### **DRUTHI- TRIBAL VISIT:**


